

PREGNATAL CARE

1) One-on-one Nurse consultations, offering comprehensive prenatal education, preparing parents for their baby.

2) First trimester 3/4 D ultrasounds reveal detailed images of baby, providing a connection with the father and growing the bond between mother and child.

3) We offer prenatal vitamins and post-partum self-care kits to expectant mothers with the goal of promoting women's well-being and ensuring a smoother transition into motherhood.







A MEMORABLE VISIT

Our clinic provided a breathtaking experience through a 3D Ultrasound to Elena*, who came to The Crossing for support.

Elena and her husband recently immigrated to the United States from Latin America in search of a better future. While her husband has secured a job, they have limited support, no health insurance, and little understanding of the healthcare system. Our Nurse collaborated with them to eliminate barriers by establishing care with a local OBGYN. Grateful for this new-found connection, the couple plans to return to The Crossing and participate in our Earn While You Learn Program.



A FUTURE DOCTOR

Clara*, a resilient physician-to-be, is pregnant, navigating the uncharted waters of single parenthood, and realizing she needs support. The first time she came to The Crossing, we discussed balancing the anticipation of her impending residency and the weight of a partner who faded away when an unplanned pregnancy surfaced.

She recently experienced the joy of an ultrasound, marking a poignant connection between her challenges and the life she carries. Clara is participating in our Earn While You Learn program, a stepping stone towards the knowledge and support crucial for her journey. We are excited to see Clara eager to unravel the mysteries of motherhood.



FINDING COMMUNITY

Alberto* came to The Crossing seeking stability for his family as they adjusted to life in Manitowoc. With children of varying ages and needs, he consistently chose lessons that helped him become a better father.
